The SDMetrics Source Code License includes:

1. The Java source code of the SDMetrics V2.0 metrics engine. This comprises the entire functionality that is available via SDMetrics' command line interface:
 - Customizable XMI import, user-definable meta model and XMI transformations.
 - Calculation of user-definable metrics.
 - Calculation of descriptive statistics.
 - Checking of user-definable design rules.
 - Design comparison: calculation of metric deltas and comparative descriptive statistics.
 - Calculation of user-definable relation matrices.
 - The model dump feature.
 - Export of data in these formats: .txt, .csv, .html, .xml for Microsoft Excel XP, .sxc for OpenOffice.org Calc.
 - Export of graphs in .svg, .png, and .jpg format (export to .png and .jpg requires a JRE 1.4 or better).

SDMetrics' graphical user interface is not part of the source code license.

2. The rights to modify the source code, and internally use applications generated from the modified source code. Licensees have no obligation to disclose their source code modifications.

The Java implementation will run with Sun's JRE1.2 or better, except for the graph export feature indicated above. The implementation additionally requires a SAX compliant XML parser such as Crimson or Xerces when running with JRE1.2/1.3 (an XML parser is part of the JRE since version 1.4).

The source code comes with complete and up-to-date javadoc documentation, in English. Source code samples are available on request. The javadocs for the public API are available at <http://www.sdmetrics.com/javadoc/>.

The source code license is non-exclusive and non-transferable; the (modified) SDMetrics source code and documentation may not be resold, rented, leased, published, or otherwise transferred or distributed.

The SDMetrics Binary License includes:

1. The Java implementation of SDMetrics' metrics engine.
The binary is delivered in form of a partially obfuscated jar file (SDMetrics.jar). The functionality and requirements are the same as stated for the source code license.
2. The rights to internally use applications that use SDMetrics.jar.

SDMetrics' graphical user interface is not part of the binary license.

The binary license comes with documentation of the metrics engine API (javadocs) in English (see <http://www.sdmetrics.com/javadoc/> for the javadocs of the public API).

The binary license is non-exclusive and non-transferable. The API documentation may not be resold, rented, leased, published, or otherwise transferred or distributed.

The XMI Parser Source Code License includes:

1. The Java source code of the SDMetrics V2.0 XMI parser. This functionality comprises:
 - User-definable meta model.
 - Customizable XMI import via XMI transformations for XMI versions 1.0, 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 2.0, and 2.1.
 - API to access the model information extracted from the XMI file (see <http://www.sdmetrics.com/javadoc/sdmetrics/model/package-summary.html>).
2. The rights to modify the source code, and internally use applications generated from the modified source code. Licensees have no obligation to disclose their source code modifications.

The platform requirements and availability of source code documentation are the same as stated for the SDMetrics source code license. The source code license is non-exclusive and non-transferable; the (modified) SDMetrics source code and documentation may not be resold, rented, leased, published, or otherwise transferred or distributed.

The XMI Parser Binary License includes:

1. The Java implementation of the SDMetrics V2.0 XMI parser.
The binary is delivered in form of a partially obfuscated jar file (SDMetrics_XP.jar). The documentation of the API, functionality and requirements are the same as stated for the XMI Parser source code license.
2. The rights to internally use applications that use SDMetrics_XP.jar.

The binary license is non-exclusive and non-transferable. The API documentation may not be resold, rented, leased, published, or otherwise transferred or distributed.

The rights for commercial redistribution include:

The rights to commercially redistribute -

- for the binary license: the entirely obfuscated SDMetrics.jar/SDMetrics_XP.jar file
- for the source code licenses: the compiled and obfuscated Java .class files generated from the (modified) source code

- as part of software products ("compound software products").

No further royalties are due for the commercial exploitation of compound software products. Licensees have no obligation to disclose information on their customers or distribution of compound software products.

The compound software products must not be in direct market competition with SDMetrics. Typically, this is the case if the compound software products offer substantial additional functionality and single user licenses are sold at a higher price than SDMetrics.
